Description

Purified Influenza B virus strain B/Florida/4/2006 is propagated in SPF chicken embryonated eggs. The virus was isolated from a human patient in 2006 and was deposited by the Florida Department of Health and purified by sucrose gradient centrifugation. It has applications in respiratory disease research, in vitro infectivity assays, antiviral studies, spiking studies, and a variety of other research.

ATCC highly recommends that appropriate personal protective equipment is always used when handling vials. For cultures that require storage in liquid nitrogen, it is important to note that some vials may leak when submersed in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

Growth Conditions

Host: SPF chicken embryonated eggs, 9 days

Effects: hemagglutination of red blood cells

Temperature: 35°C

Recommendations for infection: Dilute virus in DPBS prior to inoculation.

Incubation: 3 days in a humidified atmosphere.

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ATCC VR-1804PQ is a high-titer, purified, live virus suspended in 1X PBS + 0.1% Sodium azide. This product was prepared from ATCC VR-1804 via purification through sucrose gradient centrifugation, and is devoid of cellular debris and contaminants.
